for storage. Our goal is to enable you to expand your ideas, techniques, and color palette through experimentation and fun! Open to intermediate to advanced skill levels.





TILE MAKING WITH ANAT SHIFTAN Saturday – Sunday, April 4 – 5 | 10am – 4pm Public Lecture Sunday, April 5th at 4:30pm

In this workshop, Anat Shiftan will teach a few simple

techniques for designing tile prototypes for press molds. These prototypes will be cast in plaster for the production of multiples of the master tile. Students will learn how to press tiles in the mold successfully. Techniques will include naturalistic and graphic tile-relief renderings and raised line designs. Students will work on up to 3 tile designs and make molds for each finished design.



ANAT SHIFTAN - THE GARDEN

April 4 – May 16 | Slide Lecture April 5 at 4:30pm

As part of our yearlong gallery focus theme of Welcome Home, Anat Shiftan brings her work to the Clay Art Center in a solo exhibition with themes of the domestic garden. Anat Shiftan creates ceramic three-dimensional still life and centerpieces. Historically, still life depicts arranged elements from nature and life in the outdoors of the domestic world, and leans on the symbolic agency of these items to suggest a critique of the human condition. Inspired by the power of still life and the role of the centerpiece in domestic life, Anat creates arrangements that echo this history. She asks the viewer to question the legacy of nature, the botanical, and our material culture.
